**Background**

The Orange County Sanitation District (OCSD) provides wastewater services to approximately 2.5 million people in Orange County. OCSD operates the third largest wastewater system on the West Coast, consisting of over 650 miles of sewers and two regional wastewater treatment plants.

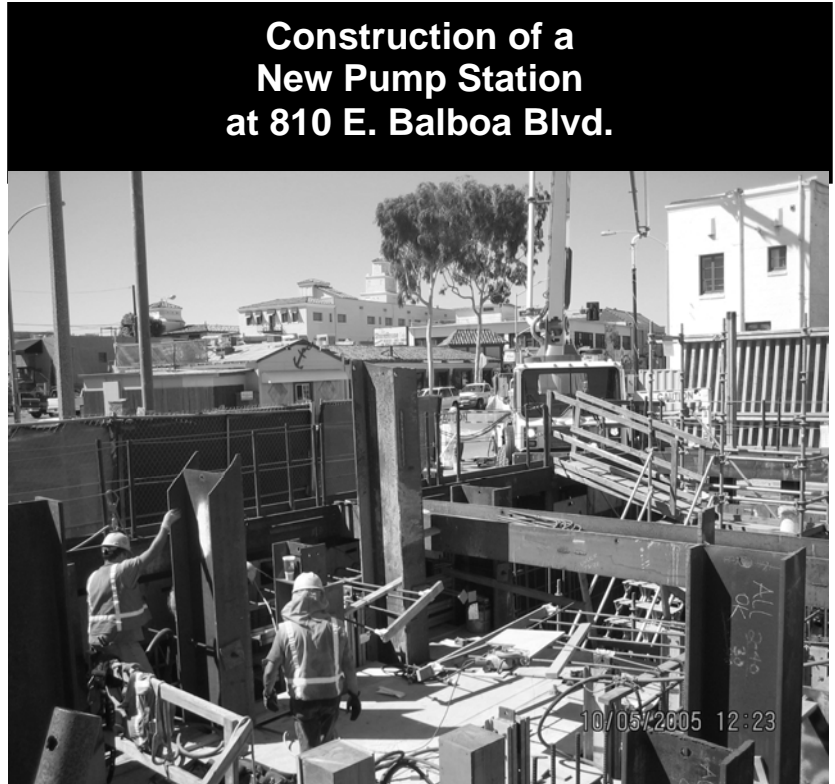
This regional sewer system is designed to work with gravity to move wastewater to its two treatment plants in Huntington Beach and Fountain Valley. OCSD owns and operates 17 pump stations in the collection system to pump the wastewater to higher ground.

A pump station located beneath the street at Balboa Blvd and A Street cannot be modified to meet necessary seismic and safety codes or reliability standards. Therefore, OCSD will construct a new pump station at 810 E. Balboa Blvd to replace it. (*Job Name: Replacement of A Street Pump Station*) The electrical equipment will be in a building above ground level with the pumps below ground.

Please be assured that OCSD has planned construction activities in a manner that will minimize the impact to you.
