EnerTech contract terminated



During the June 27, 2012 meeting, OCSD's Board of Directors terminated OCSD's contract with EnerTech because of EnerTech's inability to meet contractual performance requirements. Effective July 1, OCSD stopped sending biosolids to EnerTech's Rialto facility.

As discussed in this [related article](#), OCSD is continuing to meet our diversity guidelines with our existing contractors.

OCSD's ocean discharge permit renewed
